Campaign Finance Contribution Adjustments

Effective Date: August 1, 2023

Pursuant to Aurora City Code Section 54-105(d), the following adjustments have been made to the campaign finance contribution limits:

Amendment to ACC Sec. 54-105:

(a) During an election cycle, a person or political committee, other than a small donor committee, may not make aggregate contributions to a candidate committee or recall defense committee in excess of ~~\$400.00~~ **\$450.00** to any one candidate in any one ward race or ~~\$1,000~~ **\$1,150** to any one candidate in any at-large race or mayoral race.

(b) Small Donor to At Large/Mayor Candidate or Recall Defense	<u>\$11,500.00</u>
(e) Nonmunicipal Political Org to Candidate or Political	<u>\$450.00</u>

Basis and Purpose

ACC Sec. 54-105(d) requires contribution limits be adjusted by the City Clerk by an amount calculated by the Colorado Secretary of State as prescribed in the Colorado Constitution, Article XXVIII, Section 3(13). The first adjustment must be done by the end of the second quarter of 2023 and then every four years thereafter, by the end of the second quarter.

Constitution, Article XXVIII, Section 3(13) states each limit on contributions shall be adjusted by an amount based upon the percentage change over a four-year period in the United States bureau of labor statistics consumer price index for Denver- Boulder-Greeley, all items, all consumers, or its successor index, rounded to the nearest lowest twenty-five dollars.

- Formula: (Current contribution limit) x (Four-year percentage change in CPI) = Amount of increase
- Four-year percentage change in CPI: 16.2%.
