To establish a lawn or replace an existing one and/or install or replace an existing irrigation system; applicants MUST complete this application if:

LAWN PERMIT

- Areas 250 sq. ft. or greater of new turf grass areas
- Areas 250 sq. ft. or greater of turf grass replacement
- Project occurs any time of the year
- Areas less than 250 sq. ft. that will be using a automatic irrigation system

IRRIGATION PERMIT

- Any new installation
- Any replacement or update of an existing system
- Any addition to system (e.g., front yard to back)
- Project occurs any time of the year

APPLICATION STEPS AND REQUIREMENTS OF PROJECTS:

- Submit and pay for permit application
- Complete irrigation system if appropriate
- Prepare turf grass area with minimum of 4 cubic yards/1,000 sq. ft. with compost – Rototilled 6 inches deep. A list of acceptable compost can be found at aurorawater.org.
- **Contact Conservation at 720.859.4364 or via email at conservationinspections@auroragov.org to schedule an inspection (2-3 days prior to installing sod or seed.) Do not discard compost receipts prior to inspection. Load tickets may be requested.**

PLEASE COMPLETE ALL INFORMATION

With your permit, you are allowed to water new sod and seed as needed and between 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. New seed is granted a watering exemption for 30 days, and new sod is granted a watering exemption for 20 days.

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

- If needed, complete irrigation system
- Prepare turf grass area
 - Add a minimum of 4 cubic yards/1,000 square feet with compost
 - A list of acceptable compost can be found at AuroraWater.org
 - Rototill compost 6 inches deep
 - Load tickets are required
 - If requested, email your compost receipt to loadtickets@auroragov.org

In accordance with Ordinance No. 2004-75 and Irrigation Standards Sec. 138-192:

- Commercial and large property irrigation systems require irrigation plans review
- Single family detached and duplex developments
 - Do not require an irrigation plans review
 - Must adhere to irrigation equipment requirements and inspections

The following describes the basic requirements of the ordinance.

POP-UP SPRAY HEADS

Need to be:

- 4" for single-family residential
- 6" for non-single family residential
- 12" for flower and groundcover beds

Must have:

- Built in check valve & pressure-regulating stem

ROTOR HEADS

Must have:

- Surface diameter of less than 2"
- Minimum pop-up height of 4"
- Check valve built into bottom of body

CONTROLLERS (CLOCK/TIMER)

Must have:

- Multiple programs and start times
- Water budgeting and/or cycle and soak features
- Memory retention
- Battery backup
- Flexible day programming for any intervals

REQUIRED ON ALL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

- Rain sensor (automatic rain shut-off)
- All systems require backflow prevention

IRRIGATION EQUIPMENT EXAMPLES

POP-UP SPRAY HEADS

ROTOR HEADS
