

## School Issues

Contacts typically consist of requests for the following:

- Concern about speeding
  - a. Concerns about speeding are best addressed through enforcement activities. Please contact your local PAR officer for more information.
  - If you are concerned about speeding on a local or collector roadway, you may be eligible to apply for a traffic calming device through the City's Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program. Visit [auroragov.org/trafficalming](http://auroragov.org/trafficalming) for more information.
- 2. Reduced speed zones/Flashing beacons
  - a. By City policy, reduced speed zones are not appropriate for arterial roadways. Reduced speed zones for either collector or local streets are evaluated on a case by case basis.
- 3. Signage to prevent parking/U-turns
  - a. The City works hand in hand with local school districts to appropriately sign parking and U-turn restrictions. Additional requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis.
- 4. APS requests for bus parking zones
  - a. The City works hand in hand with local school districts to appropriately sign bus parking zones. Requests from a non-established school contact will be confirmed through an established school contact prior to any action taking place.
- 5. General school safety issues (congestion at entrances/exits, crosswalks, bike lanes, lack of school safety zone signage, request for turn restrictions, blocking of driveways or crosswalks)
  - a. The City works hand in hand with local school districts to address these concerns.
